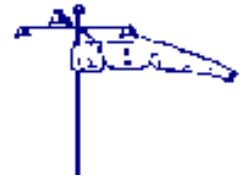

4/2/05 RALLY

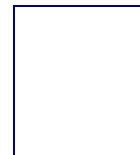
